Area 1

Making it Personal: In the gospel, we learn that God lavished His love on sinners while they were still in their sin. How do you experience God's forgiveness and sense His valuation of you? Do you feel like His treasured possession? If not, cry out to Him and express it.

Area 2

Sharing it with someone:

Who is someone you respect and honor? How might you express that to them today? Who might I pray for today - and plan to connect with them. Who am I discipling—who is discipling me?

Area 3

Sharing it with others:

Consider parents' command to teach their children and children to honor their parents. Read together (Eph 6:1-3 and Deut 11:19-21) - how are both parent's and children's responses to do and honor related to the promise of the Land?
